## ICE ETIQUETTE

*Buffalo skating Club requires all skaters to follow the ice etiquette rules for skating. These rules are for the benefit and safety of all skaters. Ice Monitors and Board Members will be enforcing these rules. Skaters who do not comply will get a warning and may be asked to leave the session if they do not improve their behavior.*

- Skaters should enter the ice only after the zamboni has LEFT THE ICE, and the doors ARE CLOSED. You MUST EXIT the ice immediately when the zamboni doors open.
- Check in with the monitor before you enter the ice. Those who have not registered for the session must give their switch to the monitor **before** you begin to skate.
- Higher level skaters should be careful of less experienced skaters and should set a good example. Less experienced skaters should also be aware and careful of the higher level skaters.
- There will be no fooling around while on the ice. This includes, but is not limited to, profanity, kicking the boards with toe picks, playing tag, deliberate bumping or tripping, sitting on the boards.
- **Use of IPODS and MP3 players while on the ice is strictly prohibited.** This is for your safety as well as the other skaters on the ice.
- Skaters performing their program to the music being played have the right of way. They will be wearing a green sash on their waist. All other skaters must yield to that skater.
- Music will be played in order of the line unless a coach requests music to be played during a lesson. Then that music will be moved to the end of the rotation.
- During the week prior to a competition or test session, skaters competing or testing will have priority over other skaters on the ice.
- No eating or chewing gum on the ice. Only plastic /paper containers are allowed at the boards. NO COLORED LIQUIDS should be on the boards or benches. This includes coffee. Please remember to be neat and clean up after yourself on the rink and in the warming room. This includes TISSUES being put IN THE TRASH.
- Make sure all tapes, bottles, sweaters are removed from boards at the end of each session.
- Skaters need to keep moving on the ice. If you want to rest or talk with parents or friends, please leave the ice.
- If you fall on the ice and are not injured, please get up immediately!
- Do not practice spins or congregate in the corners of the ice. The four Lutz corners need to remain clear for those skaters setting up their Lutz jumps.
- Parents/Guardians, and Coaches are responsible for the conduct of your child/skater.

*I have read the rules and etiquette of skating with Buffalo Skating Club and I agree to follow them. I understand that if I do not follow the rules I may be asked to leave the ice.*
